This funding will be used to:

- ensure 100% of students in Years 3 and 5 are provided with the means to meet the National Minimum Standard (NMS) in NAPLAN testing for literacy and numeracy in 2018
- ensure students achieve a 'C' or higher in the curriculum for their age cohort year level or the year level identified in their Individual Curriculum Plan (ICP): English (>83% Students attain a 'C' in 2018).

Our initiatives include:


- providing targeted literacy/numeracy intervention to support Years 3 and 5 students to reach NMS in 2018 and support Years 2 and 4 students in meeting NMS in 2019
- providing a consistent approach to the explicit teaching of reading: The Daily 5, Café, SCORE, WTW, CARS, Grammar and Punctuation (Transformations), in ability-based groups
- engaging students in online learning programs in literacy and numeracy to assist in consolidating explicit instructions from teachers and individualised student support (intervention and extension)
- continuing to build a deep understanding for teachers of the Australian Curriculum: English and unit metalanguage, within the Pioneer Valley Cluster and district schools, to improve student performance in 2018 and beyond
- building teacher capacity and capability in delivering effective teaching pedagogy around reading strategies.

Purchasing subscriptions to online learning programs for whole school use – Mathletics, Reading Eggs, Typing tournament.	\$1 100
Releasing teachers for English planning / moderation days – unpacking units (understanding metalanguage), modifying English Guide To Making Judgements for multi-age contexts, developing non-negotiable components and moderation of writing units.	\$1 700
Purchasing HOC from cluster school to assist in implementing a whole school approach to planning for the Australian Curriculum: English.	\$2 600
Employing additional staff to support Years 3 and 5 (before May 2018) and Years 2, 4 and 6 students (after May 2018) to reach NMS.	\$10 100
Releasing teachers for Age Appropriate Pedagogy personal development visits to district P-2 exemplary classroom.	\$ 905
