
Investing for Success

This funding will be used to

Attain 75% of students achieving C or higher in English & Mathematics in Semester 1. Attain 85% of students achieving C or higher in English & Mathematics in Semester 2.

Enable 100% of students articulating their reading goal.

Attain 100% of teachers engaged in data literacy discussions.

Enable 100% of teaching staff engaged in the Coaching / Mentoring process.

Our initiatives include

- Planning and an enacting a whole school approach to the teaching of reading, informed by internal monitoring and driven by student goals and feedback.
- Purchasing of Head of Curriculum days (HOC) to assist in literacy development and planning.
- Implementation of whole school pedagogical practices in reading.
- Identifying and developing high impact teaching strategies that assist to deepen pedagogical knowledge and capability for differentiated, focussed and intensive teaching.
